
## The Swiss Education System

- ! Transition 1: Baccalaureate -> Universities of applied sciences (practical training)
- Transition 2: Federal Vocational Baccalaureate or Specialised Baccalaureate -> Universities (additional exam)
- Two years of kindergarten or the first two years of a first learning cycle: included in compulsory education in the majority of cantons
- <sup>2</sup> Lower secondary level: 4-year scuola media in the Canton of Ticino (pursuant to exception clause in Art. 6 HarmoS Agreement). Transition to Baccalaureate Schools possible after 10th school year
- Vocational education and training (apprenticeship): training in a host company + instruction at a VET school + branch courses. For certain professions, a VET diploma can be obtained in a full-time school programme (e.g. in trade or IT schools).
- <sup>4</sup> FVB 2 Federal Vocational Baccalaureate after apprenticeship: full-time 1 year or part-time 2 years.
- $^{5}\,$  Federal examination / Federal diploma of higher education = ISCED 6 Advanced federal examination / Advanced federal diploma of higher education = ISCED 7
